WHAT'S On VIEW

Kathy Halper- January 10 - February 18, 2024

Kathy Halper is a self-taught mixed media artist based in Evanston, IL. Her works explore the beautiful, humorous, and mundane moments of everyday life. She utilizes unconventional materials and warped perspectives to create multi-dimensional narrative pieces that invite the viewer to contemplate their own routines.

Paul Verburg-January 10 - February 18, 2024

Paul Verburg's works emerge from an experimental fusion of representational and abstract imagery. Shapes, figures, and patterns are redefined by their visual qualities and relationships to one another, playing with the viewer's sense of familiarity. It is in this intersection between the familiar and unfamiliar that Verburg crafts his personal narrative.

Jack Demuth-January 10 - February 18, 2024

Jack Demuth's posthumous exhibition features a series of self-portraits inspired by his complicated relationship with shooting birds on his grandparents' lowa farm. He explores the psychological implications of his engagement in the activity by integrating bird illustrations into his self-portrait drawings.

Sarah Kaiser, Joseph Taylor, Mark Cleveland-February 10 - March 3, 2024

This exhibit features the works of Sarah Kaiser, Joseph Taylor, and Mark Cleveland. The assembled works present a variety of landscape scenes, transporting the viewer from the recognizable streets of Chicago to ambiguous rustic countrysides and sunlit beaches. The artists exemplify diverse approaches to the landscape genre, taking up naturalistic detail and abstraction to varying degrees.



Nina Irwin-February 24 - March 31, 2024

Nina Irwin deploys a unique self-developed mono-print technique to create her semi-abstract landscape paintings. Inspired by her own travels and studies of art history, Irwin crafts peaceful and idyllic natural scenes that welcome the viewer to join her in a spiritual quest for truth and beauty in the natural world. Her strategic manipulation of texture and color conveys a sense of place that transcends physical space, exuding a localized sense of feeling.

Barbara Curtis-February 24 - March 31, 2024

Barbara Curtis' works explore the relationship between the human body, water, and independence. Her pieces feature figures immersed and swimming in vibrant bodies of water. Aquatic spaces become the site of a universal search for independence as bodies navigate both the boundlessness and constraints of the water.

Loyola AP Show- March 6 - March 10, 2024

The Loyola Academy students work together to curate, install, and publicize the event, as well as speak publicly about their artwork and inspirations. The artwork is beautifully executed and offers audiences a window into what is on the minds of our younger artists.




