PALETTE: WET PALETTE, GLASS PALETTE, PAPER PLATES (CHEAP & DISPOSABLE), PALETTE PAD (DISPOSABLE)

SEVERAL FABRIC RAGS

BRUSHES: NATURAL BRISTLES, SET OF DIFERENT SIZES AND SHAPES-ROUND, FLAT, FLAT-ROUND (AVOID SYNTHETIC HAIR THEY COST MORE AND LAST MUCH LESS) SABLE BRUSHES ARE VERY GOOD QUALITY BUT EXPENSIVE: A VERY GOOD INVESTMENT THOUGH

CANVAS: ANY SIZES CAN BE USE, FOR BEGINNERS THOUGH IT'S BETTER NOT TO START TOO BIG. 16"X 20" IS A GOOD SIZE TO START WITH

FOR STUDIES AND FIRST STEPS GET A CANVAS PAD: ECONOMIC AND CONVENIENT
