

Supply List Pen & Ink & Watercolors Michelle Kogan

NOTE: You do not need to purchase all here. Select a few penholders; nibs; India ink; regular watercolors: primary colors and earth tones by Holbein, Winsor & Newton; a few bottles of Dr. Martin watercolors- primaries: red, blue, yellow and a brown; a couple different papers. Add items as your budget allows. Find in your home a mixing tray and containers for water.

Dr. Martin Transparent Watercolors

List below are Transparent Dr. Martin Watercolors- they are highly concentrated- At Dick Blick look for Dr. Martin Radiant Concentrated Watercolor; on line look for Dr. Martin Synchronomatic Transparent Watercolor: on Amazon or <http://www.docmartins.com>

- **Select** 1-2 blues; yellow, 1-2 reds; 1-2 browns my choice * below. Substitute a close color if one isn't available **3 from below yellow, blue, and red**

Transparent Dr. Martin Watercolors:

These aren't lightfast, but are beautiful brilliant colors

- *Ultramarine Blue (cool blue)
- *Cerulean Blue or Turquoise Blue (warm blue)
- *Nile Green
- Chartreuse
- Cadmium (this is yellow) *Daffodil Yellow
- *Scarlet (warm red) Wild Rose, or Carmine (slightly cooler red)
- *Van Dyke Brown (dark brown similar to sepia)
- *Light Brown (golden brown)
- Yellow Ochre (Similar to raw umber)
- Medium Gray, Dark Gray
- *Burnt Sienna (reddish brown)

- **Mixing Tray** with edge: metal, plastic, butcher tray-or **cookie sheet**
- **2-3 Brushes**: round watercolor brushes # 2, 4, 5, or larger, **Japanese sumi/bamboo** brushes
- 1-3 Micron pens #02 or larger (try them out in the store)
- Micron Brush Pen, or Pentel Brush Pen (this costs more but is worth it)

Dip Pens - holder & variety of nibs: A-5, A-2, B-6, C-4, make sure nibs fit penholder

- Bamboo pen

- Black India Ink- Bombay Black Dr. Ph. Martin's waterproof or other permanent waterproof
 - White India Ink-Bombay Ink White Dr. Ph, Martin's
 - Water containers, paper towels/tissues, apron-watercolors and ink are permanent
 - Board for attaching paper: foam core, gator, drawing
 - Drafting tape, Painters tape, and or Bulldog metal
 - Watercolor tubes/cakes if you have them and brushes
 - Sketchbook-small or paper for sketching your composition
 - Drawing pencils –Staedtler Mars #3b & Pencil Sharpener
 - Kneaded eraser
 - Reference materials and/or objects
- Paper: Select 1– 2 sheets or 1 pad of Coldpress 140 lb**
1-2 sheets 30 x 22 inches Fabriano Artistic 140 lb soft bright white or white, You can also work in a sketchbook or other paper you bring in.

Painting on Black Paper

Select one pad of PAPER or a couple of sheets:

–Legion Stonehenge Aqua Black Watercolor Paper Pad–
8" x 10" or 9" x 12"– I have used this paper, and like it, also it's available in the Evanston Store.

–Richeson Black Art Paper Bulk Packs
9" x 12"– –I have not used this paper yet.

–Shizen Black Watercolor Paper

Select a size. This paper has a deckle edge. I have not used this paper yet.

Or the sheet of Black paper that comes in the Arches Watercolor blocks, protecting the block
Or any 140 lb watercolor paper sheets available online.

–2 Sakura Gelly Roll Opaque White Pens #10 Bold Tip –**GET THESE**

–Dr. Ph. Martin's Bombay India Ink - 1 oz. White–you may need to order this online from Blick or Dr. Martin's– I ordered mine from Dr. Martin's website.

–Or White watercolor paint

Also other opaque watercolors, i.e. Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Orange, Jaune Brilliant, Brilliant Pink, Cerulean Blue, etc. Use these base colors to mix with additional colors.

–Your Watercolor brushes.
