- Drawing materials, charcoal, graphite pencil or colored pencils
- sketch pad 9x12 or smaller.
- Canson XL Mix Media Pad 18x24
- Stretched canvas (suggest 24"x30" or larger).

- Acrylic paints (recommend Utrecht or Golden) available at Dick Blick (37 ml) tubes in the following colors:
 - Lemon Yellow
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Cadmium Red Hue or Cadmium-free Red Medium
 - Prussian Blue
 - French Ultramarine
 - Phthalo Green (Blue Shade)
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Burnt Umber
 - Ivory Black
 - Titanium White (You will need a 200ml large tube of white
 - Utrecht or Golden Acrylic medium

- Containers for water/medium – Large yogurt container and small cat food cans work nicely.
- Palette knife or set of knives
- Large palette paper pad (Blick) or Reynolds Freezer Paper (available at the grocery store)
- Roll of paper towels or cotton rags

- Variety of Brushes round and flat size 6-12 Sets available at Blick for under \$8

 - Loew Cornell Round Bristle Brush Set of 12
