

Supply List Colored Pencil Drawing Studio

1. Colored pencils. Bring what you own! If you don't own any, I recommend starting with a set of 24. Prismacolor or Faber Castell Polychromos are good starting brands,
2. Make sure your set includes a white colored pencil. Prismacolor or Caran d'ache Luminance brand is recommended for this one. Both are available in open stock at Blick.
3. There are multiple papers that can be used with colored pencil and they will all give different results. Vellum bristol paper is a good starting point. Smooth bristol paper, hot press watercolor paper, or mixed media papers are okay. Legion Stonehenge paper is a higher quality paper that is worth investing in if you are more advanced.
4. A colorless blender pencil.
5. You will also need a drawing pencil, eraser and pencil sharpener as well as basic sketching or drawing paper.
6. Tracing paper.
7. More supplies will be discussed as the class progresses and are optional.
