- A small set of artist quality oil pastels (~12 artist quality sticks - Sennelier Oil Pastels,

Caran D'Ache Neopastels, or Mungyo Artist Oil Pastels). Alternatively, if you'd like to try

a few different brands, buying a couple open stock sticks from different companies will

give you a sense of the varying hardness and opacities of oil pastels across brands)

- A medium size pastel paper drawing pad in neutral tones or grays (Canson Mi-Teintes

makes a 12x16 inch pad with different medium toned colors, or something equivalent)

Optional Materials (we will discuss these at the first class - you don't need to purchase before

then)

- Palette knife

- Blending stump

- A small tube of solvent-free gel (e.g. Gamblin Solvent Free Oil Gel Medium)
