1.25 oz or 37 ml tubes of oil paint in the following colors:

Alizarin Crimson

Cadmium red light (hue is okay)

Ultramarine Blue

Cobalt Blue (hue is okay)

Cadmium yellow light (hue is okay)

Cadmium yellow medium (hue is okay)

A 150 ml or 5 oz tube of Titanium White

Non-turpentine solvent such as Gamsol or Sennelier# oil thinner.

Natural bristle brushes both brights or flats and filberts in a variety of sizes from #1 to #12. Some synthetic brushes are okay.

Paper towels

Plastic bag for trash

Roll of white 1" Artist Tape

Glass containers with lids.

Palette

Palette knife

12" x 16" Arches oil paper in a 12-sheet pad. (Blick carries this.)

At least three 8"x 8" Raymar art panels (C15DP Claessens Linen Panels oil primed).
(These can be ordered by the panel or in packages of five from www.ramarart.com
If you wish to substitute another painting surface make sure it is oil primed and not acrylic.)
