Required materials from Blick		
	<p>Graphite pencils You need the following: 2H, HB, 2B, 4B, 6B, 8/9B. My preferred pencil brand is Prismacolor Turquoise.</p> <p>These can be bought individually or as part of a set. Most sets will have more pencils than you need.</p>	<p>\$7</p>
	<p>Mechanical white plastic eraser This is a plastic/vinyl eraser that can be easier to use for small corrections. General Factis and Staedtler are my favorites.</p>	<p>\$6</p>

	<p>Art Alternatives Drawing Tools Set or Alvin Drawing Tools Set</p> <p>Kit comes with one blending stump (large, about 5/16" or 3/8"), one tortillion (small, 3/16" or 1/4"), one sandpaper pointer, one natural artist chamois, and one small kneaded eraser that we'll keep only for graphite.</p> <p>If you can't find the kit, please purchase the following items separately: sandpaper block or pointer, kneaded eraser, small tortillion or paper stump, eraser shield.</p>	<p>\$9</p>
	<p>Canson XL Mixed Media Pad, 7 x 10"</p> <p>This paper is optimized for many different types of media with a slight tooth (texture) and the thickness of the page (measured as 98 lbs) is thicker than copier paper (usually 60 lbs). We'll use this paper for less finished drawings, quick sketches, and brainstorming.</p>	<p>\$9</p>

<p>You'll need to purchase the items below separately from your Blick kit. These supplies can be ordered online or found in other local stores within walking distance.</p>		
	<p>Utility knife for sharpening pencils Any retractable utility knife will do, but the Workpro Folding Utility Knife (blue/red knife on the left) is my favorite (Amazon). Do not get a knife that has snap-off blades, only one that can take replacement blades. Find at Amazon, Ace Hardware, Blick, or Target.</p>	<p>\$2-15</p>
	<p>Small lidded tupperware or ziplock bag We'll use this to hold pencil shavings. Lidded yogurt or take-out food containers work great.</p>	<p>\$0</p>
