

Supply List Collage and Beyond

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General Supplies

Paper varieties (we will discuss paper types during our first class)

A basic watercolor set. (Please buy a set with strong pigment. The number of shades is not important. We will learn to mix colors. A set of 6 is perfect, but it is up to students)

* **Old magazines** like National Geographic and similar or any other printed materials that can be used for **collage-making** (also colorful photos with a variety of shapes, pictures of plants, animals or anything else that is visually interesting)

***a variety of paper:**

Watercolor paper

Mixed media paper

some cardboard

(this will be explained during our 1st class)

White and black acrylics, basic red, basic blue

brushes

palettes

3. black paper, scissors, X-acto-knives, glue, soft pastels, a cutting board

4. pencils, eraser, charcoal

(we will discuss what might make an object "interesting" on the 1st class)

*All supplies can be Student Grade. There is no need to buy expensive paints or brushes.

The paper however has to be of the right type and quality.

The instructor will also bring a variety of materials for students to experiment with.

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
