

Supply List Sewing Machine Basics

The Evanston Art Center sewing lab is stocked with basic sewing machines that we will use for this class. You do not need to bring your own sewing machine!

Student Supplies:

You are responsible for bringing the following supplies with you to class, the EAC sewing *is not stocked* with the basic supplies for this class.

- Basic sewing supplies (fabric scissors, thread snips, sewing pins, pincushion, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil)
- One spool of white or off-white all-purpose sewing thread (such as Coats & Clark Dual Duty, or Gutermann Sew-All)
- Fabric to sew a tote bag (see below)

The instructor will supply you with fabric for the first day of class lessons. The fabric requirements for the tote bag project will be discussed on our first day of class, you can ask questions and I can help you with suggestions on where to find fabric.

Fabric:

Use a medium weight, 100% cotton woven fabric 44" – 45" wide in either a solid color or print to make the tote bag.

Yardage:

Outside of the tote: either ½ yard fabric, or two fat quarters

Inside of the tote: either ½ yard fabric, or two fat quarters

Bag handles: either ¼ yard fabric, or one fat quarter

Optional pocket: Use a fat quarter or a large scrap of fabric
