

Supply List Introduction to Creative Patchwork Quilting Erika Mulyenna

Learn the basics of sewing machine quilting by making samples of traditional and modern patchwork quilt blocks and finishing them into a mini-quilt.

Read below to find out what to bring on the very first day of class, and what we'll discuss in class for purchasing once the class has started.

FIRST DAY OF CLASS

You will be provided fabric the first day of class as we sew a test quilt block to introduce basic techniques and discuss tools and materials, for the rest of the class. Please bring these supplies the first day:

- 18" x 24" self-healing cutting mat (anything smaller will prevent proper cutting)
- 6" x 24" acrylic ruler (look for one made for quilting, the marks will be easier to read when cutting)
- 45mm rotary cutter (there are different handle styles, pick one that works for you)
- Basic sewing supplies; scissors, thread snips, pins, seam ripper, pincushion
- One medium spool of white, All-purpose polyester 40-weight sewing thread (Gutermann Sew All Thread is sold at most sewing/crafting/quilting stores)

TOOLS AND MATERIALS NEEDED AFTER THE FIRST DAY

These are tools and materials that we'll thoroughly discuss the first day in class so you know exactly what to pick up to make your patchwork mini quilt.

- FABRICS; please use 100% cotton medium-weight fabrics for patchwork.
 - o Patchwork blocks amounts needed discussed first day
 - o Backing, sashing, borders discussed later in class, amounts will vary
 - o Batting:
 - 100% cotton quilt batting, purchase craft or crib-sized packaged batting
 - o Binding:
 - Methods and yardage discussed later in class
- TOOLS needed later in class will be discussed before you need to purchase
 - o Quilt basting pins (curved safety pins
 - o Blue painter's tape (we don't need much, consider splitting a roll with classmates)
 - o One spool 100% polyester 40-weight embroidery thread for quilting (matching or contrasting with quilt top)
