Beginning Quilting II: Machine Quilting and Finishing

The Evanston Art Center sewing lab is stocked with basic sewing machines for use in the quilting class. If you wish, you may bring your own sewing machine for this class (you can use the elevator to the second floor classroom at the back of the building if you are carrying in your own machine).

Student Supplies:

You need to bring the following supplies with you to class, the EAC sewing *is not stocked* with the basic supplies you need for quilting.

- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, pincushion, thread snips, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil)
- One spool of white or off-white all-purpose sewing thread (such as Coats & Clark Dual Duty, or Gutermann Sew-All)
- 45mm rotary cutter, 18" x 24" quilters' self-healing cutting mat, and quilters' 6" x 24" acrylic ruler

The instructor will supply you with fabric for the first day of class lessons.

What you will need for the remainder of the quilting class will be discussed on the first day, you can ask questions and get advice about what you will work on for the rest of the class.

If you have enrolled in Beginning Patchwork I: Patchwork Basics course, you will use four of the blocks you created in this first session to finish a mini-quilt in this quilting class. If you are only enrolling in the Machine Quilting & Finishing class, you can use other quilt blocks, fabrics, or materials to practice the techniques in class (and I can help you determine what you'd like to do on day 1).
