Here are some of the items recommended to prepare:

1. Rubber boots & Vinyl apron

2. Mould and deckle (the art center has a couple of mould and deckle to share, but it is always nice to bring your own)

I use these two sizes.

3. Pellon

This is just my suggestion. There are so many different kinds. As long as it's non-fusible, you could try different thickness.

4. Cutting boards

To press out water after couching.
