

## Supply List Screenprinting/Printing Sellable Goods *Hiroshi Ariyama*

-Paper of your choice. -Other materials such as textiles in form of t-shirts, tote bags etc. -Your own ink, if specific color inks are preferred.

## If buying your ink:

Speedball branded ink made for screen printing is most cost-effective. They have a line that's made for fabric printing where you heat-set after to have the ink infused with fabric to make it more permanent.

Blick has their own brand of acrylic ink that's intended for fabric printing too. In my experience, regular acrylic ink can work with retarder such as silkscreen medium by Golden.

Initially, I would encourage people to print on light color fabric. I will go over the subject of opaque vs translucent inks in class.
