### Black and White Darkroom Photography

- 1) Black and White 120 Film  
*Suggested: HP5 Plus Black and White Negative Film ISO 400 (120 Roll Film)*
- 2) RC Developing Paper: 5x7 or 8x10  
*Suggested: Ilford Multigrade V RC Deluxe Pearl Surface Black & White Photo Paper*
- 3) Archival Storage Sheets 120 Negative Page Preservers.
- 4) Medium Format Camera

Students are suggested to bring their own medium format camera. If they do not have their own, we can provide a Holga camera for students to borrow. The Holga is an affordable way to break into medium format photography.

Students looking to bring their own camera plan to bring the following or similar:

- Holga 120N Plastic Camera (Holga 120GCFN, Holga Panorama, etc.)
- Medium Format SLR Camera (Pentax 645, Mamiya RZ67, Hasselbald 500s, etc.)
- Medium Format TLR Camera (Rolleiflex, Yashia 635, etc.)
- Medium Format Rangefinder (Mamiya 6 Medium Format, Fujifilm GF/GM670, etc.)

- Small Gaffer Tape
- Notebook and pen for notes
- 3-ring Binder or Film Negative Storage Box
- Ilford Anti-Static Reusable Cleaning Cloth
