Precautions

The Evanston Art Center asks anyone with a fever or cold and flu-like symptoms such as a cough, sore throat, runny nose, or body aches to refrain from visiting the EAC while these symptoms persist.

Testing Positive for COVID-19

 - Refund policies for students are waived in the event a student must miss a scheduled class due to COVID-19. Students may be asked for proof of a positive COVID-19 test.
