### CAMP CURRICULUM

### VISUAL ARTS CAMP: AGES 4-5

Each camp nurtures the exploration of materials, promotes visual literacy, and supports the development of behavioral and emotional skills. Our camps prioritize skill development by teaching students to recognize and explore creating with various colors, forms, lines, and textures.
