Supply List:

- Sakura Pigma micron pens (variety of sizes and colors of your choice, but at least 003, 005, 01 in black)
- Selection of watercolor brushes, or a single Pentel Aquash waterbrush, medium tip (<https://www.dickblick.com/items/19925-2001/>)
- Bristol Pad, Smooth, 9x12” (<https://www.dickblick.com/products/strathmore-300-series-bristol-board-pads/>)
- A few sheets of hot press watercolor paper (I recommend Arches 140lb Hot Press paper, if you buy two 22x30” sheets, you can cut it up into smaller pieces that will be sufficient) (<https://www.dickblick.com/products/arches-natural-white-watercolor-paper/>)
- Palette of your choosing, I prefer ceramic but plastic will work nicely (https://www.dickblick.com/products/masters-international-folding-watercolor-palette/?clickTracking=true&wmcpl=pla&wmcid=items&wmckw=00067-1001&gclid=Cj0KCQjw wY-LBhD6ARIsACvT72OBC4bg3G9QHQQNnnBwHYICnvuH1lazqpxlFi3rOzMTgXMLTx yo-LgaAo-NEALw_wcB). A white plate also works in a pinch.
- Watercolor paints of your choosing
- graphite pencil
- eraser
- Paper towel
