Capturing Light in Colored Pencils

1. Colored pencils. Bring what you own! We will talk about brands and specific colors in the first class. If you don't own any, I recommend starting with a set of 24. Prismacolor or Faber Castell Polychromos are good starting brands,
2. However! If you do not own a white colored pencil you will need one. Prismacolor or Caran D'ache luminance is recommended for this one.
3. Pad of vellum bristol paper. I use Strathmore but any brand is ok. You can also use hot press watercolor paper. Arches and Fabriano are good brands.
4. Prismacolor colorless blender pencil. Available at Blick or Michaels. Blick link is below:

6. Please also have a drawing pencil, eraser and pencil sharpener as well as basic sketching or drawing paper. Tracing paper is useful but not essential if you own a window that gets sunlight.
