

## Supply List Capturing Light in Colored Pencils Lyndsay Murphree

- 1. Colored pencils. Bring what you own! We will talk about brands and specific colors in the first class. If you don't own any, I recommend starting with a set of 24. Prismacolor or Faber Castell Polychromos are good starting brands,
- 2. However! If you do not own a white colored pencil you will need one. Prismacolor or Caran D'ache luminance is recommended for this one.
- 3. Pad of vellum bristol paper. I use Strathmore but any brand is ok. You can also use hot press watercolor paper. Arches and Fabriano are good brands.
- 4. Prismacolor colorless blender pencil. Available at Blick or Michaels. Blick link is below:

6. Please also have a drawing pencil, eraser and pencil sharpener as well as basic sketching or drawing paper. Tracing paper is useful but not essential if you own a window that gets sunlight.
