# Beginning Quilting I: Patchwork Basics

Bring a few basic supplies on the first day of class (listed below), and we'll discuss what you'll need for the remainder of the session.

### FIRST DAY OF CLASS

Don't worry about bringing FABRIC on the first day! You will be provided with fabric on the first day of class as we sew a test quilt block to introduce basic techniques and discuss the tools and materials used for the rest of the class. Please bring these supplies on the first day:

18" x 24" self-healing cutting mat recommended (12" x 18" will work in a pinch)

6" x 24" acrylic ruler (look for one made for quilting; the marks will be easier to read when cutting)

45mm rotary cutter (there are different handle styles, pick one that works for you)

Basic sewing supplies: scissors, thread snips, pins, seam ripper, pincushion

One medium spool of white, All-purpose polyester 40-weight sewing thread (Gutermann Sew All

Thread is sold at most sewing/crafting/quilting stores)

We'll be sewing at least one block per class; some of you may have time to sew more than one block. On the first day of class, we'll talk about how much fabric you need to purchase/bring to make blocks for the remainder of the session. I'll give you guidelines for picking out colors that will make for great looking blocks, and how much you might want to purchase based on how many blocks you may want to make (if you plan to keep making blocks after class ends).
