Paint Your Travels: Watercolor or Acrylics

Students are welcome to work in a variety of media, but in each media what is needed is:

- Basic primary colors plus white (red, yellow, blue)- preferably

each student would have enough variation for double primaries- that is a cool red(alizarin) and a warm red(cadmium or pyrrole), a cool blue

- (cerulean) and a warm blue(ultramarine), and a cool yellow(hansa or benzadazalimine) and a warm yellow (cadmium or primary yellow)

Introductory class will have an intro to colors/how to use what you have on hand

- Acrylic or Watercolor brushes (a medium to large round #8 or thereabout, and a smaller liner or rigger brush #2)

Intro class will talk about brushes, and how we can use what you might have on hand

- Depending on media an appropriate surface- watercolor or mixed media paper, canvas or board for painters- for those using color pencil or pastels a drawing paper

Part of this class is learning about materials, what to buy and how to use them.
