Part 1: Drawing

- Graphite drawing pencils with various levels (2H, HB, 2B, etc.)
- Dense eraser: choose from Staedtler white, pink pearl, or something comparable
- Eraser pencil: Tombow or Tuff-stuff are refillable
- Strathmore 300 series sketch pad, 14 by 17 inches or larger
- Pencil sharpener
- ruler
- Ink pens of various size tips (Fabercastell brush pen, micron, copic, etc)

Part 2: Painting

Watercolor brushes (have short handles).

Princeton Velvet-touch

- small rounds (#1, #2)
- ¼" angled shader
- ½" flat and/or filbert
- 1" wash brush

Watercolor paper (block recommended)

Paper size: about 12" by 16" maximum

Cold-press, at least 140 lb

Good brands: Arches, Strathmore

Watercolor paints: either tubes or pans.

Colors: Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Red or Scarlet Lake, Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Viridian, Burnt Sienna

I recommend a **Winsor-Newton Compact Set with half pans**. Available at Blick and Amazon. Priced between 20 and 40\$, depending on size.

Other good brands: Daniel Smith, Utrecht

Palettes:

Butcher tray, and something with dividers

Water cups (2)

Small Spray bottles

Sponge(s)
