

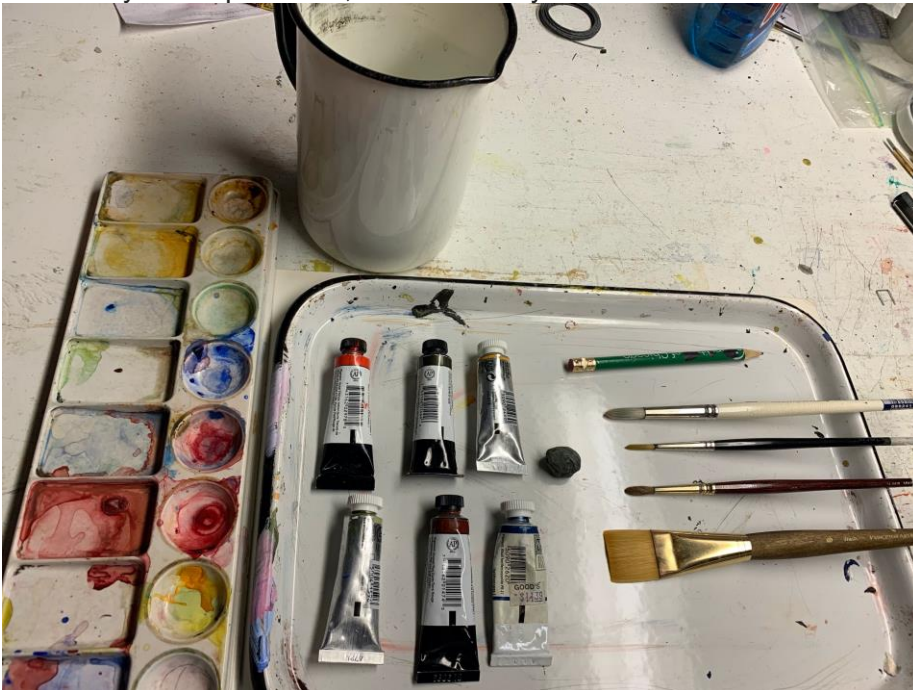
Supply List

Watercolor in the Abstract

Pictured below are the supplies you will need.

- **If you already own brushes, tube paints and high quality paper, bring them to class and we will figure out what works and what doesn't.**
- Paper: watercolor block, not a tablet! 140 pound cold press. Blick or Arches brand
- Mixing tray (I have a few extras which I am selling for \$8).
- Water container. An old plastic carton will suffice. Large, not small.
- Palette to hold various colors (on left)
- 1" flat edge brush
- Pointed **watercolor** brushes: numbers 8, 6, 4 or close to these numbers
- Tube paints:
 - cobalt blue,
 - ultramarine blue
 - alizarin crimson, cadmium yellow (medium preferred)
 - burnt sienna
 - cadmium orange
 - **If you already own tube paints, bring them to class. Don't run out and buy anything until I see what you have.**
- Kneaded eraser
- Soft lead pencil
- I will supply the water and paper towels
- If you shop at Blick, mention that you are a student at EAC. You will earn a discount.
