

## Supply List

### Bloom in Watercolor

*Chelsea Dubick*

A set of watercolors. Pan is fine, the more colors the better. 24 or more. No need to spend a lot on these, especially at first. Student watercolor sets are fine. If using tube colors, please bring a pan to spread them out in.

A white pan or plate for mixing

Towel

Paper towel

A selection of watercolor brushes, 3 or more. One large one for covering larger areas, one for detail, and at least one medium size.

Watercolor pencils

Lead pencils

Eraser

Sketchbook of drawing paper

I prefer cold press watercolor paper with a smoother (but not too smooth) finish. However, plenty of artists prefer hot press, it's up to each artist. I prefer a bit bigger, 11" x 14" or larger, with the option to cut down to size when needed.
