### Botanical Drawing: Basics and More

"What to bring to the drawing workshop"

The EAC will provide paper and flowers.

Workshop participants will need to bring:

1. Graphite pencils: various softness, for example, 2H, H, (F), HB, B and 2B. Pencils from the same brand are recommended.
2. A container to hold flowers fresh. For example, a floral frog pin holder, a small glass jar, or anything that can keep the flowers in the way you want to draw. Remember: it's important to keep your specime in the way you like to draw, but they don't pose perfectly for you! :)
3. Drawing board, or anything that can provide firm surface for drawing
4. Divider (compass) and ruler for accurate measurement- if you don't have these, eyeballing and measuring with a pencil will work, too. :)
5. A magnifying glass is strongly recommended to do more precise work. Instructor will bring a few to share, but please, bring it when you have one. I suggest [this magnifying glass](#). Please, make sure to choose 5". If not, you will get a small one.
6. Bring a few sheets of extra paper for practice. A regular sketchbook or any drawing paper will be good.
