

Supply List

List for Students to bring:

-Pre washed* several white cotton fabrics (approx. 2 yards) *Wash fabric with warm water with soap. Fabric must be 100% natural material.

No surface treatment. No polyester mixture.

You may experiment on linen, silk, bamboo, rayon

NO T-shirts or large garment or table cloth. We have limited size of indigo vat.

NOTE: Cotton bandana, silk scarf, muslin fabric are available to purchase from the instructor in class if students cannot get fabric.

-Rubber gloves (ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY!)

-Sketch book or notebook, pencils

-Rubber bands (several different sizes)

-Something for resist: e.g. 3-4 bobby pins, a pair of chop sticks, 2-3 wooden clothes pins, clips, popsicle sticks

-Strings or twine, or Crochet thread or strong thread (e.g. button or carpet thread) to wind your fabric on PVC tube

-Masking tape; prefer PAINTERS TAPE (blue tape)

-Newspaper (approx. Sunday newspaper)

-Large towel (e.g., bath towel)

-Container (carry wet fabric from dye bath to rinse, etc.)

-Small bucket or tub to wash your fabric

-Scissors

-Plastic bags (take wet fabrics home)

optional

-Disappearing marking pen or chalk (mark on fabric)

-12" ruler

-Apron

-Thin gloves
