July 9 - August 21, 2022

Kitchen Table Stories

Curated by 2021/2022 Curatorial Fellow Melissa Raman Molitor

A celebration of stories shared by 29 local artists who identify as Asian, South Asian, and Pacific Islander. The exhibit will center 'care' as an art form that draws on cultural wisdom, ancestral healing and collective power, reflecting on universal themes such as language, food, home, family, and heroes.

July 16 - August 14, 2022

Lea Basile-Lazarus: ENVIRONMENTS On view: July 16 – August 14, 2022

ENVIRONMENTS features the work of printmaker and paper pulp painter Lea Basile-Lazarus. Moving through the unusual, intersecting "environments" created and heightened during the pandemic and a relocation to the Pacific Northwest, Basile-Lazarus works her reactions and meditations on these changes into her vibrant and richly-textured prints, embossments and paintings.

August 20 - September 25, 2022

Yvette Kaiser Smith: Drifting Inside Traditions

In reaction to Covid lockdowns concurrent with widening divisions within our society, Yvette Kaiser Smith combines dissimilar materials and multiple material and technique languages—acrylic sheet scraps, paper gift bags, industrial felts, and embroidery stitches of various yarns and threads. This work challenges our perception of differences, asking viewers to consider whether we see diversity as a hard difference that leads to the notion of otherness, or as variation within a unified group, others as part of us.

August 20 - September 25, 2022

The Needle's Excellency

Contemporary Needlepoint Created at The Needle's Excellency From a traditional craft to a contemporary art form, this exhibit features needlepoint artwork from The Needle's Excellency, a local shop in Evanston that carries a wide range of designs, fibers, accessories and needlepoint finishing and framing.

August 27 - October 2, 2022

Lavered Meanings

Featuring the work of Sherry Karver, Robert McCann and Lilach Schrag

Though vastly different in their artistic expressions, Sherry Karver, Robert McCann and Lilach Schrag present complex explorations of personal and societal alienation, contradiction and conflict found in modern life.

October 1 - November 6, 2022

Susan Beiner: Hive Expanded

Hive Expanded displays a shift to ideas about installation, covering an expanse of space. Intense brilliant color reveals an obviously artificial man-made reality. The encrustations are abstracted from real plant life, allowing the viewer to proceed into the interior pattern of a stylized manufactured plastic plant life within our environment. We participate in the growth and development of plants, technologically as well as emotionally as we celebrate their bloom.

November 12 - December 18, 2022

Connie Noyes

A multidisciplinary artist, Connie Noyes has had many notable solo exhibitions and residencies in the US, and has gained international recognition with exhibitions in Germany, France, Austria and the UAE, where she represented Salwa Zeidan Gallery at Art Abu Dhabi. After her father and husband died within days of each other, Noyes' work has been an immersion in mourning research. Regardless of our differences, grief is a common ground. Connecting on this commonality, she brings personal ritual objects out of the studio and into the community to connect in intimate, creative and regenerative spaces for healing.

January 7 - February 12, 2023

David Anthony Geary

Inspired by culture, beauty, science, mythology and experience, the transdisciplinary artist David Anthony Geary is simultaneously engaged in the now, then and still to come. Each piece is a dance between intention and intuition, a process of exchange, discovery and experimentation informed as much by the moments of their creation as the research that precedes them. The portrait specifically serves to explore the nuance of identity.






