

Cash awards and cash equivalents will be awarded, and are given at the jurors' discretion.

#### ACCEPTANCE

Notification of acceptance will be emailed by July 10, 2023. A valid email address is required.

#### ELIGIBILITY

The 26th Evanston + Vicinity Biennial is open to artists 18 years of age and older living in Illinois. All work must be original and completed within the last two years. All mediums accepted. A non-refundable entry fee of \$35 is required from each artist.

#### CONDITIONS

The Evanston Art Center (EAC) reserves the right to refuse any work which differs from the submitted images. All accepted entries will be considered temporary loans to the EAC. The EAC will assume insurance responsibility for the object upon receipt and inspection, and during the exhibition. The EAC is not liable for any claim for loss, theft or damage of any kind during transportation. The EAC will exercise the usual care in handling and will provide insurance coverage subject to EAC policy guidelines. It cannot be responsible for minor wear resulting from normal handling.
