



Anyone enrolling must adhere to EAC's studio policies on Designed for advanced students who want to work on their own or with a small group of advanced students outside of class in unmonitored studio time. To be permitted to work independently in the studio during designated times, students will be trained in five one-hour authorization sessions. After which they will be evaluated and may be allowed to work independently. The AOS Coordinator will arrange rapid-fire demos, class outings, guest artists, and other events tailored to the group's needs and interests. EAC's well-equipped studio will be at your disposal to create, improve your skills, and become part of a supportive artist community!
