

Watercolor and Gouache 101 Color, Texture, Movement

You can put together a watercolor palette with tube paints, or buy a palette with pre-filled wells.

- Watercolor Tubes Color suggestions: - buff titanium, cobalt turquoise, phthalo green, perylene green, sap green, green gold, cerulean blue chromium, ultramarine blue, phthalo blue, imperial purple, indian red, pyrrol crimson, pyrrol scarlet, quinacridone rose, yellow ochre, new gamboge, hanse yellow medium, hanse yellow light, goethite, raw umber, burnt umber, raw sienna, burnt sienna, quinacridone gold, moonglow

- Paper (watercolor block, cold or hot press depending on your choice surface smoother or rougher) A good brand is [Strathmore](#), but any will do.
- Pencil, eraser, sharpener, and painters tape (masking tape will do).
- Variety of Brushes (Flat, pointed, rounded, dagger, wide, narrow) The most important are a fat flat brush and a round pointed brush. I love a dagger brush as well.

Optional:

- White gouache. You can add black, and any of your favorite colors for opaque
- India ink
- Scissors
