#2 pencils
1 pink eraser
1 Pencil sharpener
1 4 oz bottle of Elmer's glue
Brushes (example Crayola White Taklon set)
1 set of acrylic paint or watercolor palette
10 sheets of drawing paper or copy paper
2.5lb bucket Crayola air dry clay
Sculpey III Set Classic Collection or (4 colors of 2oz Sculpey III of your choice)
Activa Activ-Tools Clay (Can substitute with a Metal fork, Plastic knife, and a Bamboo Skewer)

Supplies to Collect/Recycled Materials from Home

Smallish cardboard box (shoe box or smaller)
Paper plates
Toothpicks
Aluminum Foil
Newsprint
2 plastic or paper cups
Paper towels
Resealable Plastic bag
Small wood rolling pin (can also use a smooth water bottle or smooth drinking glass)

Not required, but handy to have

Old plastic take out containers (to store air dry clay or to use a painting palette)
Plastic or Styrofoam egg cartons (for sculpture, molds, or to hold paint)
Plastic food containers (i.e. large Yogurt containers)
Flat cardboard sheets
Sticks or popsicle sticks
Saran wrap (to protect keyboard)

Materials for Space: How to Prepare for Art-Making

1. Newspapers for work surface
2. Keep paper towels or small towel nearby
3. Apron, smock, or large T-shirt
4. Masking tape (tape down cloth or newspaper)
5. Book or stand to elevate computer (keep it safe from spills)
6. Keep Trash bin nearby
7. Saran wrap for keyboard
8. Designated sink for cleaning
9. Be near sink OR have old towel nearby to wipe hands if needed
