LATE PICK-UP ARRANGEMENTS

If you cannot pick up your child until 4:30 p.m., they can stay with a Teaching Assistant and continue to work on their projects started earlier in the day. \$15 per day. Advance notice is needed. Contact the Director of Education to arrange.

OUTDOOR BREAKS PLANNED

Campers visit nearby McCulloch Park for a break during the day, weather permitting. We suggest you pack sunscreen and any sun protection your child may need. Students are typically given an option of continuing to work or going outside – both options include supervision by our great camp team members!

GIVE US 2 WEEKS FOR CLAY PROJECTS: Afternoon clay projects will be available beginning about 2 weeks after camp. The EAC will contact you via email when the projects are ready for pick-up. You will have a 4-week period to pick up the projects from the EAC.
