

Supply List Introduction to Colored Pencil Lyndsay Murphree

- 1. Drawing Pencils
- 2. Hard, white eraser
- 3. Ruler
- 4. Drawing paper/sketchbook
- 5. Colored Pencils. Recommended brands are Prismacolor or Faber Castell Polychromos. Any brand is fine as long as it isn't Crayola. A set of 24 or more is ideal as it gives you choices of color. However, we will work with whatever you have on hand.
- Paper for colored pencil. There are a lot of papers to work with, and all will yield different results. I
 recommend choosing bristol paper with vellum finish (for example, Strathmore) or hot press
 watercolor paper.

Some optional materials are tracing paper, scotch tape, a colorless blender pencil (Prismacolor makes a good one), and 91% isopropyl alcohol **or** odorless mineral spirits.
