1. Drawing Pencils
2. Hard, white eraser
3. Ruler
4. Drawing paper/sketchbook
5. Colored Pencils. Recommended brands are Prismacolor or Faber Castell Polychromos. Any brand is fine as long as it isn't Crayola. A set of 24 or more is ideal as it gives you choices of color. However, we will work with whatever you have on hand.
6. Paper for colored pencil. There are a lot of papers to work with, and all will yield different results. I recommend choosing bristol paper with vellum finish (for example, Strathmore) or hot press watercolor paper.

Some optional materials are tracing paper, scotch tape, a colorless blender pencil (Prismacolor makes a good one), and 91% isopropyl alcohol **or** odorless mineral spirits.
