Sketching for Busy People

You don't need to purchase supplies unless you really want to. This is about having fun and learning skills. You can use what you have on hand, really for the first half of the class. By the second half, See "By week 4" below.

- Soft drawing pencil- Ebony is ideal- but not necessary
- Small plastic eraser, any shape or color- nothing gritty.
- Small pencil sharpener
- Light colored paper. If you want to order some, get Strathmore drawing paper. Its ivory in color. But any light paper will do!
- Flat work surface such as a clip board or book

I will go over an optional supply list the first day of class, but as a guide, by week 4, you will need:

- Black conte or charcoal pencil
- White conte or white charcoal/soft white pastel pencil
- Black china marker
- White china marker
- Black card stock OR black sketch paper (no larger than 8 X 10")
- White card stock OR white sketch paper (no larger than 8 X 10")

- Multimedia pad , Strathmore preferred

- Woodless, water soluble graphite pencil- Koh i noor if possible. Derwent is OK

Small soft rags or soft paper towels

3x5"-8X10"(roughly) scraps of brown craft paper, paper bags or smooth scraps of similarly colored and textured cardboard
