### Your Signature Script - Writing the Italic Way

Recommended Supplies to start with:

1. Ordinary ink pen (like a Bic pen or any kind of regular ballpoint pen that you have at home) or a regular #2 pencil – these are “monoline” tools that make a single narrow line.
2. Broad nib pen and ink of your choice: if you already have one, it’s probably suitable for this class. If you do not already have one, please choose one of the two following broad-nib pens:

Either: Shaeffer Viewpoint Calligraphy Pens - Mini Kit (we’ll be using the B nib)

Or: Pilot Parallel Pen 2.4mm (the orange one)

3. Practice Paper: Any kind of lined or unlined 8-1/2 x 11” paper for practice – copier paper is fine, notebook paper is fine
4. Scrap paper for messy trial-and-error to protect your table or writing surface (newspaper or brown bag paper is fine for this)
