1 Watercolor tray (Recommend Richeson 8-Well Slant Mixing Tray)

2. Protect table surfaces from water and possible paint stains.

2. Collect or take pictures of small natural object, that look interesting to you for possibly including in your artwork, such as seed pods, shells, and stones.
